Medicare Advantage Risk Adjustment Telehealth Benefit Years 2023 & 2024

For Medicare Advantage, telehealth visits are only considered to be equivalent to face-to-face interactions when <u>use of video</u> is documented.

- Medicare Advantage risk adjustment requires a face-to-face service, i.e., video is required for telehealth
- Place of service
 - The place of service code on the claim should be 02 (other than patient's home) in 2023
- Modifier 95 indicates the use of audio and video during the visit
- Modifier FQ, audio-only service, may be used when the patient is unable to use video, but it is available
 - \circ $\;$ This must be documented in the progress note
- May use office E&M codes
- May see new or established patients
- May be used for annual depression screening
- May be used for AWV, initial and subsequent
- May not be used for IPPE (welcome to Medicare visit)
